



The Citrus Squeeze Contest Rules and FAQs

What is the Citrus Squeeze Contest?

A five member team will compete to create the wackiest costumes and contraptions designed to squeeze the most juice possible in a 10 minute contest. Each team will be provided tables, oranges & buckets - - the rest is up to your team!

Teams may use any manually operated process imaginable for separating juice from their oranges, but will not be allowed to use anything electric or motor-driven. Showmanship is a key criteria and bonus points are awarded to teams whose uniforms and squeezing contraptions demonstrate creativity and ingenuity. Each team has 1 runner and 4 squeezers. The oranges are placed in a central location, and at the sound of the whistle, each teams runners race back and forth to the pile to retrieve the oranges for their team. For the next 10 minutes, the squeezers get as much juice as possible into their Official Citrus Squeeze Juice Collection Bucket. The team with the most juice, after bonus points have been calculated, will be named champion and will be awarded the coveted Citrus Cup.

When is the Contest?

It will be held at the Ferran Park on Saturday, February 27, 2010 at 4:30 PM.

What is the Registration Fee? \$50 per team.

Scoring

The team which registers the most inches of juice, including their bonus points, will be declared the Champion and receive the trophy. Other awards include:

1st, 2nd & 3rd Place for the team with the **MOST CREATIVE** juicing process.

1st, 2nd & 3rd Place for the team with the **BEST COSTUMES**.

1st place for the **CROWD FAVORITE** team.

The Rules

1. Runners are limited to the quantity of oranges they can carry in their arms. No containers are allowed, nor can runners use their shirts as "baskets." Runners may go back and forth to the pile of oranges as many times as they choose during the contest.
2. No part of your juicing process can be set up closer to the Orange Pile than indicated by the perimeter markers.
3. If any team members is using a knife to slice oranges, that person **MUST WEAR A STURDY PROTECTIVE GLOVE** on the hand holding the oranges (oven mitts are an acceptable alternative). No cuts, no lacerations, no exceptions.
4. No team members may interfere with another team's efforts to collect or squeeze oranges.
5. You will be informed when the race is nearing its end, so when the final whistle blows all squeezing must stop and only the juice already in your bucket will count towards your score.
